CONTRACT FOR SERVICES

This contract is entered into between The Group of Seven (G7) ("the Client") 22, avenue Lofoi, Lubumbashi, and Ballard Partners, Inc. ("the Firm"), 601 13th Street NW, Suite 200 N, Washington, D.C. 20005.

Recitals

Whereas, the Client wishes to retain the services of the Firm in order that the Firm may provide strategic consulting and advocacy services to the Client in connection with its business with the United States government; and

Whereas, the Finn wishes to provide such representation as the Client may from time to time require; and

Whereas, the parties have agreed to the terms under which the Firm will represent the Client and wish to memorialize their agreement in writing.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained and intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Term of Agreement. This agreement shall become effective on September 15, 2017 and shall remain effective until September 14, 2018. After a joint evaluation by he Parties, this agreement shall renew for successive one-year periods on the anniversary of the effective date of the agreement unless either party terminates the agreement. Upon renewal this agreement may be terminated within thirty (30) days written notice by either party.
- 2. <u>Duties of The Firm</u>. It shall be the Firm's duty to consult with the Client and advocate on its behalf those issues the Client deems necessary and appropriate before the Federal government. It shall further be the Firm's duty to inform the Client of developments in legislation and policy relevant to the Client's operations. More specifically, the Firm will seek to provide U.S. Government support to bring about a fair and just election in Democratic Republic of the Congo. The Firm will also seek to provide UN assistance for the Client's return to the DRC and its ability to participate in its election process.

- 3. <u>Duties of The Client</u>. It shall be the Client's duty to provide the Firm the information necessary to best represent the Client. It shall also be the Client's duty to timely compensate the Firm for its services.
- 4. <u>Compensation</u>. The Firm shall receive from the Client \$50,000 a month for this agreement. If any international travel is required by the Firm, it will only be with the preapproval of the Client. The fee shall be paid as follows: the first installment of \$150,000 being due immediately upon execution of this agreement; second installment of \$150,000 due on December 15, 2017; and third installment of \$150,000 due on March 15, 2018; and fourth installment of \$150,000 due on June 15, 2018; and continuing to be due on a quarterly basis until the termination of the agreement. The Firm will bill costs quarterly.
